BACKGROUND

- ELECTRICITY SUPPLIED BY DIESEL GENERATION
- CURRENTLY 8% IS SUPPLIED BY SOLAR POWER GENERATION
- NUC 500KW SOLAR COMMISSIONED IN 2016
- NUC 1.1MW SOLAR COMMISSIONED IN 2019
- PROPOSED NEW 6.9MW SOLAR GENERATION WILL HELP ACHIEVE
 50% TARGET OF ENERGY SUPPLIED FROM RENEWABLES BY 2022
- REDUCE GREEN HOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND DIVERSIFY ENERGY MIX

Solar Project Implementation Contractor: China Harbour/HNEC/RISEN (Joint Venture)




Land area 77290.93sqm 7.73 hectares





SOLAR LAND BOUNDARIES & PORTIONS




